	<b>Prairie City Example</b>	<b>Your Estimated Cost</b>
<p><b>Collection Costs:</b> Includes but not limited to: labour, fuel, transfer, fleet maintenance and replacement, and administration of collecting waste from residents in the community. This number should be for single-family dwellings only.</p>	\$8 970 000	
<p><b>Disposal Costs:</b> Disposal costs or tipping fees refer to the cost incurred when dumping material in a landfill. Broken down, this figure should reflect the cost of operating a landfill: the costs of administration, salaries, purchasing equipment, equipment replacement and maintenance, and the closure and creation of new sites. This number should be for single-family dwellings only.</p>	\$4 340 000
